Dear Ms. Barrientos:

On June 30, 2017, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources sent your client, Mr. John Haynes, President of the Wildwood Lot Owners Association, a conditional approval letter to the Preliminary Engineering Report (PER) submitted to the Department on July 29, 2016, by Miller Companies. The June 30, letter granted approval of the PER on the condition that the proposed completion dates included in the letter were acceptable to the Association, and if the completion dates were not acceptable, the Association may submit alternative dates for the Department's consideration.

On July 18, 2017, the Department received an electronic correspondence from you, on behalf of the Association, with an attached response letter to the June 30, letter which included proposed completion dates. The Department hereby approves the proposed dates on the condition the Association completes the comprehensive evaluation of the wastewater collection system and submits to the Department a report and a schedule to remedy any deficiencies identified during the evaluation. The report must be submitted to the Department on or before March 31, 2018.

Additionally, as referenced in your July 18, letter, should the Association determine that an upcoming milestone will not be completed by the agreed upon date, the Association may request an extension to the completion date by submitting a written request to the Department for an extension which must include an explanation for why the milestone would not be met and a proposed new completion date.

Finally, in regard to the clarification mentioned in the last paragraph of your July 18, letter referencing permanent residency in the subdivision; the Department apologizes for the misunderstanding and appreciates your clarification that the Association's engineering company, Miller Companies, has recommended discontinuing full-time residency and incorporating a



grandfathering bylaw, but the Association cannot make any changes to its Covenants and Bylaws until the current litigation against the Association involving its Covenants and Bylaws is concluded.
