Mark M wanted to thank everyone that helped with the counting for the election. There were no permanent residency applications. A letter was sent out for the 3rd trailer located in Beaver park. This issue has been addressed. In the past he believed any wood leaving the park would be fined. He would like to know if anyone recalls what the fine should be. Donna K announced that \$160.00 has been donated for the playground equipment. Hank S wanted to know if we have a total cost for the equipment. Dwayne O would like to wait to see how much is raised before we decide on what equipment to purchase. Dwayne O stated that Al Vormittag has power washer to wash down the playground equipment in deer park. Dwayne O would like to get together after funds are raised and move forward. Cindy made the motion that we accept the report. Kim 2nd. Motion passed.
